



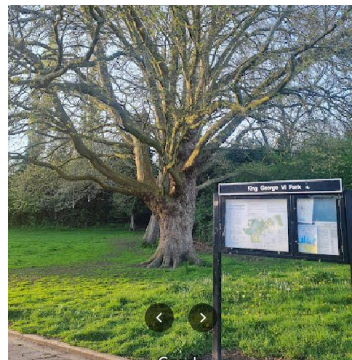

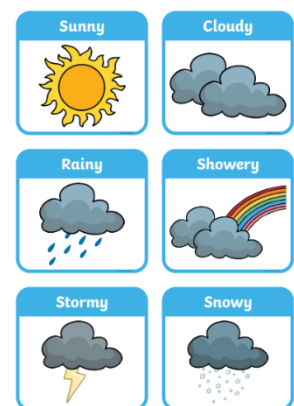
The Natural World
