Topic overview

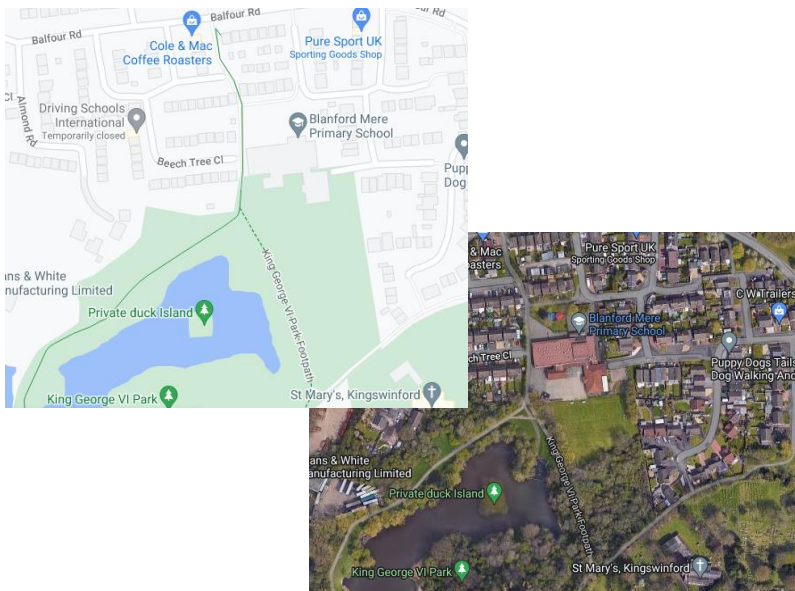
Very Important People – Children will be learning about their local area and where they live.
