In with your child's report will be the information about who your child's class teacher will be next year.















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Distribution of reports and details of your child's class next year will be as follows:

We are still adhering to the government guidance which says that we should be limiting visitors to the building/school site and observing social distancing of 2m. To keep staff, children and parents safe please follow arrangements below at all times.

- Reports will be distributed on Tuesday 30th June 2020, regardless of the weather!
- For any children who are currently attending school, we will send home their reports with them at the end of the day on Tuesday 30th June. Please note that if the child has a sibling, who is not attending school, then their report will be sent home with the child attending school. Their reports will not be available earlier in the day, so please do not come to the office for these.
- For children who are not currently attending school, you can collect their report from the main entrance on <u>Tuesday 30th June between 9.45am and 12.00pm only.</u>
- Pump bags and photographs that were uncollected, will be available at this time too.
- On entry to the site please ensure that you socially distance, maintaining 2m between yourself and the next adult to prevent overcrowding
- To limit the number of people on the premises, we would appreciate if one parent only
 collected reports (unless you need to bring your child with you, who must remain by your side
 at all times)
- I will be handing reports to parents, could you do the following please;
 - 1) Socially distance along the pathway while waiting
 - 2) Wait at the line which will be indicated on the floor
 - 3) I will place your child's report/belongings on the table and step back
 - 4) I will then indicate to you to walk forward and collect your child's report
 - 5) You will then exit via the gate on the carpark to avoid other parents who may be waiting
- To keep everyone safe, please do not all arrive at 9.45am
- If your child is attending school on Tuesday we will not be giving the report using the
 above format, so please do not wait in the queue as it will be sent home with your child at the
 end of the day
- However, if your child is attending school any other day after Tuesday 30th June and your prefer not to queue, then we will send the report home when they next attend.
- Separated parents who are already on mailing list to receive their information, will have their reports posted to them. The parent who the child resides with should collect their report, if they are not attending school
- For GDPR reasons, reports will only be handed to over to parents, not siblings, family friends or neighbours















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We hope that the information given is clear and we would really appreciate your support in making the plan work. We are giving the reports out earlier than planned.

In with the report will be a leaflet to help you register and sign up for our new lunch pre-ordering system 'School Grid'. This is extremely important to enable you to order and pre-pay (where applicable) for lunches online for your child. You may have already activated this before 'lockdown'. The office may send you a new link to follow, if they can see that you have not yet activated it. The link will only be valid for 24 hours, so please activate it, even though you will not be ordering until September.

Books

Usually, we send home your child's books at the end of the summer term for you to keep. However, due to the Coronavirus and limiting items going in and out of school and home, this will not happen this year.

We will be in touch as soon as we have more information from the government, regarding September opening.
