

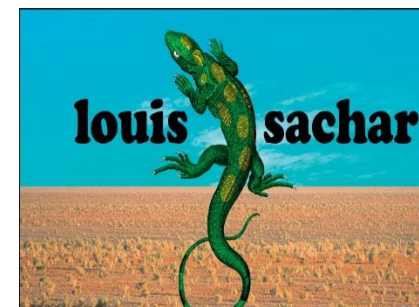
How can you help your child?

With their learning...

- ✓ Talk with your child about their school work, topics and the world around them.
- ✓ Hear your child read regularly and help them to learn spellings strategies.
- ✓ Visit the library and help your son/daughter to choose books to read for pleasure and to support their topics.
- ✓ Encourage them to use Mathletics at home on a tablet or computer.
- ✓ Play TT Rockstars to improve speed and accuracy of times tables.
- ✓ Please check your child's planner daily.
- ✓ Sign the planner every week (at the bottom of the page) so that we know homework has been completed and that all communication between home and school has been shared.
- ✓ Please help your child learn their times tables. You can find them in their planners. There are also plenty of APPs for tablets that are useful if used regularly – just search 'times tables'.

With practical issues...

- ✓ Ensure that your child has the correct P.E. Kit in school every day.
- ✓ Children should wear a tie with winter uniform.
- ✓ Summer uniform can be worn, if preferred.
- ✓ Children should not wear nail varnish or jewellery (other than a watch and / or stud earrings) for school.
- ✓ Don't forget that if your child wishes to have their ears pierced, the best time is the beginning of the summer holidays as it is
- ✓ Dudley policy that children cannot wear any kind of earrings during PE lessons.
- ✓ Long hair should be tied up for safety reasons.
- ✓ Please ensure that all uniform is marked with the child's name.



Maths

In Maths, all aspects of the National Curriculum will be covered. In particular, we will be working on fluency of maths, rapid recall of times tables, the 4 operations, real life problems and reasoning.

English

This term, our **writing** will be inspired by the text 'Holes'. We will concentrate on developing sentence structure and punctuation through a variety of genres including the correct and appropriate use of Alan Peat Sentences (APS). Our **reading** will focus on vocabulary, phonics, fluency and expression.

Comprehension will be developed through targeted questioning and reading journal activities. Weekly **spelling** tests will be taking place. Children have been given a copy of the spellings in their green spelling books which should be taken home daily. The children will be assessed through dictation and written work.

Geography

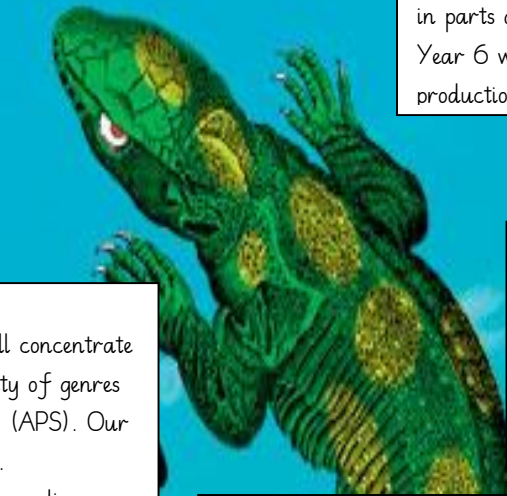
In geography, deserts around the world will be studied and used to find out about how animals and people survive in different climates.

PE

The children will be focusing on tennis and athletics, developing their co-ordination, movement and ball skills. PE is on a Wednesday for 56D and a Friday for both 56B & 56R.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will look at what affects mental health and ways to take care of it. Managing change, loss, time online and transition will also be studied. Children will be taught how to keep personal information safe and how to make sensible choices.



Music - In music, the children will be singing in parts and adding musical instruments. Year 6 will be rehearsing for their leavers' production.

Computing

In computing this term, the children will be developing their word processing and the use of ICT for communicating effectively. E-safety will be an important theme.

History

During the term, we will be studying the history of crime and punishment.

Science

The children will be studying Light and Forces.
